The following list represents items the Claremont, NH Historical Society seeks to collect. The items include, but are not limited to:

Photographs and negatives- of Claremont people, places, and events

Recordings - by audio cassette, video cassette, DVD, motion picture of Claremont people, places, and events

e.g. -

Articles made in Claremont by industries and individuals

e.g. - Monadnock Mill bedspreads, Kings Arrow Pine furniture, patten records, etc.

Articles of clothing representative of different eras worn by Claremont people

e.g. - military uniforms including medals and dog tags, wedding dresses, men's, women's and children's attire, uniforms and equipment (e.g. Claremont Pilots - baseball),

Books - by and about Claremont and Claremonters

e.g. - school yearbooks, town directories, books by Claremont authors,

Records - business and industry records, clubs and organization records
